



## MDQ SUMMER CAMP 2011

Assalamu Alykum! It's summer camp time at Masjid Darul Quran again! InshaAllah the camp will run for 5 weeks this year from July 1- July 30, kids ages 5-15 are welcome. Field trips, baking days, arts and crafts will be just some of the fun campers will experience. Please refer to the camp calendar to view our schedule.

This year camp will be based on five themes. Each week campers will learn a new theme such as: truthfulness, obedience, politeness, patience, and equality. These themes will be covered by instructors and guest speakers through group discussions, indoor/outdoor arts & crafts, short lectures & research done by students. Something new this year will be our camp garden! Campers will learn a little about gardening as they will get to plant and maintain flowers in our garden.

Camp fee this year is \$200 per child. Breakfast and lunch will be provided. On our fieldtrip days all campers will be required to bring essential material or clothing with them as needed. Permission slips will cover all the necessary info. Permission slips will only be accepted when signed by parents/guardian. For camp timings, schedule, etc. please view the camps flyer or calendar. Each student will be issued the camp calendar by his/her teacher in the first week of camp.

### **Attendance:**

Students MUST arrive on time. All absences should be reported to the school administration beforehand.

### **Dress Code:**

All students must wear modest clothing. Girls and boys must wear clothes that cover them properly. All girls must wear Hijab and no clothing with imagery is allowed. Hats/hoods are not to be worn in class.

**Graduation** ceremony will be held on Saturday July 30, 2011 in the MDQ main hall at 10 am. Campers will be given goody bags, prizes & certificates on successfully completing the camp. Group pictures will be taken. Speeches & Performances by different age campers will be followed by lunch in the Masjid basement. ### **Masjid Rules:**

- Always come to the Masjid with Wudu.
- Care for the Masjid better than our home
  - Do not litter in the Masjid
  - Modesty of dress is requested
- Observe modest behavior and a low voice
  - Respect the Quran and our books
  - Do not walk in front of anyone praying
- Clean your shoes before entering the Masjid and place them on a rack
  - Make sure you leave the washroom absolutely clean
  - Do not talk when someone is praying or reciting the Quran
    - Do not lay down or sit in a class disrespectfully
  - No eating or drinking is allowed on the prayer area.
    - Do not damage Masjid property
- Parents are responsible for any damage done to the property by their children
- Do not use bad language or display disrespectful behavior towards a teacher or fellow students
  - Remember to set aside your desk at the end of class and take your books home with you
    - Do not leave the Masjid premises any time during school hours.
